

PREMIER POLYSTEEL UMBRELLA CARE & CLEANING

Sunbrella® fabric should be cleaned regularly before dirt and other substances are allowed to accumulate on and become embedded in the fabric. The fabric can be cleaned without being removed from the installation. Simply brush off any loose dirt, etc; hose down and clean with a mild natural soap in lukewarm water (no more than 100° F.) Rinse thoroughly to remove soap. DO NOT USE DETERGENTS. Allow to air dry.

For more stubborn cases:

Soak the fabric for approximately twenty minutes in a solution of no more than ½ cup (4 oz.) of a non-chlorine bleach and ¼ cup (2 oz.) natural soap per gallon of water at approximately 100° F. Rinse thoroughly in cold water to remove all of the soap. *Note: Excessive soaking in non-chlorine bleach can deteriorate sewing threads.* This method of cleaning may remove part of the water repellency and the fabric should receive an application of air-curing fluorocarbon water repellent treatment, such as 303 Hi Tech Fabric Guard, if repellency is a factor.

Sunbrella® is made from 100% Sunbrella® Acrylic fiber which is thermoplastic. DO NOT SUBJECT TO EXCESSIVE HEAT. When Sunbrella® fabric is stored, it should be cleaned, allowed to air dry and stored in a dry, well ventilated area.
